VIAN (1858 - 1904) About: Henri Vian was a very active bronzier and produced many interior decorations, such as bronze-mounted vases, chandeliers, sconces, balustrades, always of exceptional quality. Henri Vian was the grandfather of the famous writer Boris Vian. He was also one of the best bronziers of his time. He exhibited his work at the Universal Exhibitions of 1878, 1889 (Gold Medal) and 1900. He worked for many prestigious figures and historic houses
