Description

Clock in gilded bronze pendulum with double matt and shiny patina: the goddess Hebe and Jupiter represented in the form of an eagle.

Rectangular base decorated with masks inscribed in medallions and allegorical attributes of Jupiter. Very good quality of carving and gilding.

Wire movement in perfect working order, with keys and balance wheel.

Enamelled dial signed "Rouvière à Paris", watchmaker referenced in the tardy, dictionary of French watchmakers.

Note: slight chips of use on the enamel at the level of the winders.
