Hand-colored at the time with a brush. Very good condition. Very fresh colors, minimal foxing. Monogrammed in the plate at the bottom left Made between 1841 and 1863 (see below)

Aubert & Cie is an old French company, at the same time printer, bookshop, publishing house and lithographer, founded in Paris in 1829 and disappeared in 1863. In 1841, the Aubert house moved again, and settled on Place de la Bourse, in the heart of the business district. (hence the indication of the date between 1841 and 1863) in pair with the previous one
