Period work Active until the end of the 18th century, he died after 1796, he made a number of Louis XV then Louis XVI seats to the taste of the day, going so far as to draw inspiration from his competitors, such as Georges Jacob, to maintain his activity at the highest level. Under Louis XV, Jean Avisse produced very beautiful seats. Plan to change the caning of the seat and note a slight hole in the caning of the backrest at the bottom right. Good condition of woodwork. A removable panel has been placed on hold to support the cushion to allow sitting. The cushion is in good original condition, but with a tear on its top. Seat height 40 cm, armrests 59 cm. Seat dimensions 68 x 56 cm Base
