Magnificent work by Miljenko STANCIC, an important Croatian artist of the 20th century Depicting a mother and child in an interior Miljenko Stancic (1926, Varazdin - 1977, Zagreb) graduated in 1949 from the Academy of Fine Arts in Zagreb. He completed his higher education in graphic design in the class of Professor Tomislav Krizman in 1952. Later he was an assistant professor and professor at the Academy. He was also involved in illustration, graphic design and scenography. He was a member of the "Five" (Lj.Ivancic, I.Kozaric, V.Michieli, M.Stancic, J.Vanista). He was considered a representative of surrealist painting in Croatia and art critics classified his works as magical realism, metaphysical painting, fantasy or phantasmagoric, new figuration, etc. Since
