This magnificent Indo-Persian rug follows the criteria of ancient Persian decorations.

It is knotted with great finesse and superb quality of kerk wool mixed with silk.

Around 1980, we can hardly imagine the immense work that went into knotting such a marvel.

The quality of these pieces is not to be demonstrated, the work is fine, precise and durable over time.

The materials used are of the highest quality: the fine and soft kerk wool, taken from the neck and under the belly of the lambs (first shearing) makes up the velvet knotted on a fine cotton for the weft.

This carpet is clean, the wool is knotted admirably and finely tight as these carpets always are.

It reveals to us nuances full of contrasts, very many colors including mainly ivory, cream, brown The field is surrounded by a border accompanied by fine braids grouping together branches, large stylized flowers and stars of Medes.

Traditional wool carpet, comfortable and very popular.

The nuances underline this learned floral design in the great tradition of Persian art.

Persian art that is also found in Mughal art, inspired by the miniatures of the Tabriz school, then capital of the Persian Empire.

For information: Tabriz (Azerbaijani: Təbriz/تبریز, formerly Tauris), is the capital of the province of East Azerbaijan, in the northwest of Iran (Iranian Azerbaijan).

Tabriz is located on the course of the Talkheh River (also called Aji-Chai), near Lake Urmia, near the borders of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Armenia.

It is the gateway to Persia from north to west,
