The high point of Grün's painted work is the commission received in 1909 from the Under-Secretary of State for Fine Arts, Étienne Dujardin-Beaumetz, to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the Salon of French Artists in 1911. The audacity of the broad composition and the virtuosity of the brushwork in the painting A Friday at the Salon of French Artists restore much more than the vanity of a social opening evening
