Bright view of the Marmore waterfalls in Terni in Italy. It is about a hundred kilometers from Rome. Léon Giffard demonstrates here his talent as a luminist. The touch is delicate, lively and assured in an impressionist style. Born in 1875 Léon Giffard is a French painter from Lille. He painted landscapes during his travels in France, the Maghreb and also in Italy where he was inspired by the charm of the Terni waterfalls among others. The painter appears in the Bénézit and his works can be found in public sales. This Oil is painted on cardboard mounted on canvas.
