Porcelain with underglaze painting. 28.5 cm (height) x 15 cm (width) x 9 cm (depth). Signed "Chr. Thomsen" on the back of the plinth, marked and numbered under the base.

Copenhagen's underglaze painting emphasize the rusticity of the scene. The farmer's wife, like Constantin Meunier's peasants, is not weighed down by the burden of daily work, but radiates a dignity that is reflected in the glamorous appearance of the porcelain.

The gap in the outer garment above the apron, which allows the fabric underneath to show through, is an artistic idea that further enlivens the figure.
