


Large Painting. Saint-sulpice Church And Fountain, Paris. Henri Dabadie (1867-1949).

The church, the square and the fountain of Saint-Sulpice in Paris Saint-Germain district, dated 1917. The scaffolding visible on the north tower could correspond to the restoration work carried out in 1911 following the damage caused by Prussian shells in 1871 (wikipedia). The painting would then have been painted or completed 6 years after this work.
