She is celebrated for pioneering the iconic Fairyland and Ordinary Lustre series, transforming lustreware into highly sought-after decorative art. This bowl, corresponding to pattern Z4832, is part of the Ordinary Lustre range introduced in 1914. The butterfly design was produced until 1929 and remains highly collectible today. Limited production, combined with growing recognition of Makeig-Jones' artistry, has made her works a valuable investment for collectors.
