

Wax Seal Case Silver Coat Of Arms Brumauld Hearts Vendée 39.7gr 18th



Description

Solid silver wax case* (trace of the Fermiers Généraux hallmark), chiseled with a monogram surrounding two flaming Vendée hearts; as well as a coat of arms composed of the Brumauld family crest* (broken azure chevron, accompanied by three crouching rabbits), and topped with a baron's crown, from the 18th century. This wax case is in good general condition. Hallmarked, see photos. The crest is that of the Brumauld family (originally from Poitou). Please note: some small shocks, scratches, and wear on the silver, see photos (with red arrows).

The wax case is intended to hold a stick of sealing wax; it also serves as a seal. These objects always have extremely neat finishes. Dimensions:
