Very beautiful black horn handle with filigree, monogrammed with Emperor Wilhelm II, as well as a functional keyboard called " with a flap ", in the shape of the Prussian eagle.

Plain and gilded handle with its strap.

On the straight blade has two central gutters, the punch of Carl Eickhorn in Solingen. "CE" under the squirrels back to back.

The leather thumb rest is largely missing.

Traces of use and time (nothing serious or perforating) on the black painted iron scabbard has a ring. T
