The composition, both dynamic and refined, illustrates Gertrude Hahn's characteristic approach, which sought to capture the emotional essence of landscapes while playing on the border between figuration and abstraction. The energy of the brushstrokes and the mastery of chromatic contrasts give this work a remarkable intensity, paying homage to the raw force of nature.

Elisabeth Hahn (1924-2021) was a German painter, born in Dortmund. She began her artistic studies in Germany before settling in France. In 1953, she moved to Paris, where she continued her training at the Beaux-Arts under the direction of two major figures of modern art: Jean Soubervie and Edmond Heuzé, between 1954 and 1959. From 1962, her works were presented in prestigious exhibitions, including: Les Salons de l'Art Libre, Le Salon de l'Union des Artistes. She was also exhibited in renowned Parisian galleries such as: Galerie Raymond-Creuze, Galerie Cimaïse, Galerie Everarts. Her style oscillates between abstraction and expressive figurative representations, highlighting characters, vibrant landscapes, and scenes imbued with emotional depth. Her bold use of colors and dynamic compositions have marked her work.
