



Jean Bernard Trotzier 1950 Animated Lake Landscape



Description

Our painting depicts a natural landscape scene, painted in a realistic and impressionist style. The painting depicts a river or pond bordered by trees and lush vegetation. The water is calm and reflects the sky and surrounding vegetation. The sky is clear but slightly hazy, with a soft, diffuse light, suggesting a peaceful atmosphere, perhaps at the beginning or end of the day. On the left of the painting, a woman in traditional dress (probably peasant) stands near the trees. She seems to be observing the water or enjoying the landscape. This small character adds a touch of life and scale to the composition. The tones are natural and soothing, with shades of green, blue and brown. 23 Rue Condorcet Grenoble 38000 frame, typical of works from the 19th century. Jean-Bernard TROTZIER was born in 1950 in Hayange in Moselle. He studied at the École des Beaux-Arts in Metz. He is a painter of typical scenes, landscapes and seascapes. This painter of open-air landscapes specialized in rural scenes, peasants in the fields, lively farms, as well as views of Venice. He develops the canvas on the motif by touches and works in glazes. He exhibited in Paris, Nantes, Strasbourg, Lille, Honfleur, Reims, Metz, and in Japan, Germany, the USA and Switzerland. This landscape evokes a bucolic scene typical of paintings from the end of the 19th century, where nature and rural scenes were highlighted. This painting could represent a French region, perhaps a river or lake area in the countryside. Shipping costs for France 40.00 euros
