This landscape of ruins certainly represents the Court of Auditors of Paris, destroyed by a fire during the events of the Commune in 1871. The scene is bathed in a soft light that penetrates through the stone arches and vaults, creating a contrast between the shadow of the walls and the clarity of the exposed areas. The green and dense vegetation grows through the rubble, symbolizing renewal and nature reclaiming its rights. Its
