Description

Antique Marble Fragment - Foliage Roman Art, 1st - 2nd century AD

This carved marble fragment, dating from the Early Roman Empire (1st - 2nd century AD), demonstrates the artistic and ornamental mastery of Antiquity. It features a delicate foliage decoration, characteristic of the plant motifs widely used in Roman architecture and sculpture. It may be an acanthus leaf.

Probably from an architectural element or sculpted furniture, this vestige illustrates the influence of Greco-Roman art in the embellishment of public and private spaces. The finesse of the execution and the fluidity of the forms attest to the know-how of the craftsmen of
