Description

Rare and special gilded wooden reliquary with a relic of St. Andrew inside. Later crucified in black ink (Latin cross on a mountain with three peaks?)

Italy, eighteenth century
St. Andrew is considered the patron saint of
butchers, rope makers, fishermen and
fishmongers, as well as of Scotland, Greece and
Russia. Another very curious legend tells how
girls looking for a husband must eat half an apple,
put the other half under their pillow and pray to
St. Andrew, in a dream he will tell them a secret

that will allow them to get married.
