Very beautiful border of flowers and cartouches with heraldic decoration.

The scene represented is the flight of Cleopatra from Egypt to Rome on a boat led by her vassal Apollodorus,

(the continuation of these very famous events by the seduction of Cleopatra hidden in a carpet then the idyll with Caesar allowing her to reconquer
