Created by René Lalique, this radiator cap is a testament to the golden age of automobile ornamentation in the 1920s and 1930s. At that time, radiator caps went beyond their simple function to become true works of art, prized by collectors and design enthusiasts.

Lalique, a master glassmaker and jeweler, created a series of glass mascots for luxury cars, capturing movement and grace through the transparency of the material. These pieces embodied refinement and technical progress, reflecting the elegance of Art Deco and the taste for luxury that characterized the great names in the automobile industry.
