Opal ring in 18 carat rhodium-plated gold, diamonds, vintage 80s Superb ring adorned with a natural opal of 6.34 carats, whose iridescence mainly reveals bright orange shades, a characteristic particularly prized in this gem. Blue reflections then sublimate the stone, followed by touches of green, offering a most appreciated play of colors. This opal is highlighted by a surround of brilliant-cut diamonds, totaling 0.67 carats, which accentuate its brilliance and depth. The opal is in exceptional condition, without any fractures or microfissures, which is rare for this naturally fragile stone and sensitive to variations in humidity. Unlike some opals which can present slight fractures on the surface or on the back over time, this one is perfectly preserved and offers an impeccable shine. A truly precious piece for

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lovers of rare gems. The 18-carat rhodium-plated gold setting, typical of the 1980s, shows signs of wear on the body of the ring, revealing the original yellow gold in places. It is not recommended to re-rhodium-plate the ring, as opal is a delicate stone that can be damaged by a rhodium bath. A jeweler's hallmark is present, but it is too worn to be identified. An exceptional piece of jewelry, combining the captivating beauty of an opal with vibrant reflections and the timeless elegance of diamonds.
