Indonesia, Java Island, late 19th century - early 20th century, very pretty and old mask from the Ramayana theater in polychrome wood depicting the character of the demon Rakjsasa. A leather tab, more recent because replaced due to wear and attesting to significant use of the piece, is visible on the reverse. It allowed the dancer to keep the mask on his face without holding it with his hands by biting the tab. Particularly well executed piece, both in the sculpture and in the quality of the painting.
