Kutani Porcelain Guanyin. Japan, Meiji Era, Late 19th Century.



Description

The deity is represented standing holding a scroll in her hand. Her face has a benevolent expression and from her whole body emanates a great tranquility. The goddess of mercy is sculpted in fine Kutani porcelain covered with enamels and gold, discreetly a myriad of white enamel beads in slight relief give an effect of depth to the white of the dress. It is a very beautiful representation of Guanyin which stands out for the quality of its execution from the large quantity of similar deities created at this period in Japan. Under the base 2 of the 5 Chinese characters painted in red enamel tell us that the statue was created in the kilns of Kutani, the other 3 characters must probably inform us of the name of the artist. In good condition, no restoration, only the thumb of the left hand was broken and simply glued back
