Yakshas were nature spirits venerated in Jainism, Hinduism, and Buddhism. Depictions of Yakshas and their female counterparts, Yakshis, were common on votive steles and architectural reliefs, emphasizing their protective and beneficent roles. The art of the Shunga dynasty, which succeeded the Maurya Empire, is characterized by an ornamental and expressive style, highlighting rounded forms and naturalistic details.
