Early 19th centuryFrance or EuropeA high-yield printed cotton Indian fabric intended for furniture and dating from the early 19th century, and at the latest from the first Restoration. Picot print on a very white and very tightly woven cotton, small motifs of Medici vases, laurel wreaths, coral branches and labyrinths forming antique columns. These are interspersed with floral bouquets and architectural motifs reminiscent of the decorative repertoire of the Louis XVI period. Large, clean coupon, without holes or stains. Good strength of the cotton allowing reuse for historical decoration. Good general condition.Dimensions: 321 cm x 125 cm
