Interior Of A Collector In Alsace Luc Hueber (1889-1974) I



Description

Collector's interior and homage to Alsatian decorative arts with this impressive work signed Luc Hueber, dated 1920. It includes a beautiful Alsatian chair, a statue of Joseph and Jesus, a stoneware flower vase probably from Elchinger, Betschdorf stoneware, and a beautiful Alsatian credenza, not to mention the small objects from our region which complete this charming atmosphere. Rare subject. Luc Hueber (1888-1974), originally from Sainte-Croix-en-Plaine (Haut-Rhin), is a French painter. Trained at the Strasbourg School of Decorative Arts in the field of stained glass, he perfected his skills in Munich, then settled in Strasbourg. A follower of the Realist movement that marked the Strasbourg scene during the 1920s and 1930s, he was one of the founders of
