Late 19th century - 1882 France Solid silver - Hallmark visible on the edge With its original case An exceptional academic medal Rare Prix d'Honneur medal, awarded in 1882 to Jean Loubet, a fourth-grade student at the Communauté des Clercs de Toulouse, under the authority of Cardinal Florian Desprez, Archbishop of Toulouse. Prize medals were a prestigious tradition in religious educational establishments of the 19th century, rewarding academic excellence and exemplary conduct of students. Description of both sides o Obverse (main face): o Precisely engraved relief inscription: "PRICE OF HONOR AWARDED TO MR JEAN LOUBET, FOURTH-GRADE STUDENT, AT THE COMMUNITY OF CLERCS OF TOULOUSE. JULY 30, 1882." o
