Description

Superb mother-of-pearl and solid gold knife dating from the 18th century. The knife has a mother-of-pearl handle, and the bolsters are shell-shaped. The blade is solid gold. This is an 18th-century folding knife, probably converted into a straight knife in the 19th century. The blade, handle, and shell bolsters are 18th-century; the rivets and the fillet running along the edge of the handle are later. The gold blade bears a small 18th-century stamp, which requires identification. The knife comes in a superb gilded leather case with small ironwork. Superb knife with a rare solid gold blade dating from the 18th century, modified in the 19th century. 18.6 cm long 32.4 grams Very good condition.
