Description

A prestigious mid-18th century Emilian commode with impressive dimensions (width 131 cm, depth 62 cm, height 100 cm), likely designed for a noble salon or an aristocratic residence. This piece stands out for its elegantly curved structure, with a shaped front and sides that add dynamism and refinement, characteristic of the Rococo style. Entirely veneered in walnut burl, the commode showcases an exceptional quality of marquetry, with intricate grain patterns that enhance the wood's depth and luminosity. The choice of walnut burl, a hallmark of Emilian cabinetry of the period, further elevates its uniqueness and value. The high, saber-shaped legs lend a sense of lightness to the structure, balancing the piece's grandeur while ensuring both sturdiness and elegance. The curved front
