- Sugar spoon or sprinkler - Hammered, chiseled and openwork silver - Christophe Aubertin, master silversmith from 1740-1786 - Nancy (France), circa 1750-1780 - Length: 22 cm, diameter: 7.2 cm; weight: 95 g - Perfect condition

- Sugar spoon or sprinkler with a double-lined model. The double-molded spoon is decorated with a pierced decoration of palmettes and branches forming the petals of a flower with a central bud formed by a swirling rosette with a daisy in its center. The attachment on the spoon with a ribbed shoulder. The spatula is slightly curved with a rib. - Hallmarks (twice on the stem): Master goldsmith: CA surmounting a wheel, surmounted by a thistle for Christophe Aubertin, master goldsmith in Nancy from 1740 to 1786 [2 p. 92 & 184].
