A great career will open to him where he will teach in Paris until around the 1930s, where he will leave everything to come and settle in Provence, more precisely in Méounes les Montrieux. Also passionate about nature he will leave from morning to night in all weathers, in the countryside in order to restore on his canvas the marvelous colors of the countryside and the undergrowth. He will die in 1962 in his house "Le rouge gorge". A street bears his name in Dijon. A remarkable biographical book has been produced on this extraordinary artist.
