ROUND tin dish with a wide, plain edge, called "à la cardinal", partly forged. Master's mark incompletely affixed: crowned rose / 16(--)/---/. This is probably Jonas 1er TAUDIN received master in 1635 and died in 1674. Diameter: 30.8 cm. BORDEAUX, mid-17th century Good condition This Italian form with a wide wing was introduced in France by Cardinal Mazarin from Italy. The forging often practiced at this time on plateries was intended to increase their rigidity.
