The base of the bookcase includes three additional glazed doors with ebonised trim and adjustable solid shelves, all remaining on a molded plinth base with ebonised feet. The sides of the bookcase are accented with curved ebonized moldings, enhancing its overall design. With great color and patina, France, circa 1860.
