They were transported in pairs on the back of a dromedary. A true work of art, this one is entirely embroidered in wool on wool. The refinement of the embroidery is absolutely remarkable, the patterns are precise, they seem sculpted in the material... The colors, 100% vegetable are breathtaking, their brilliance, their luminosity, their freshness are all a pleasure for the eye.
