English School of the 19th century Lively
Scottish mountain landscape Watercolor on paper

delicate watercolor depicts an emblematic
landscape of the Scottish Highlands, with its
majestic valleys and steep mountains bathed in
soft light. In the foreground, small silhouettes of
farmers or plowmen are busy in the fields,
bringing life and movement to the scene. Not far
away, a few charming rural houses, with simple
and discreet lines, punctuate the landscape,
characteristics of traditional Scottish architecture.
The artist, faithful to the romantic spirit of the
19th century, plays with the contrasts between the
harshness of the mountains and the softness of the
light, between the grandeur of nature and the
humble human presence. The palette is composed

restoring the singular atmosphere of the northern

giltwood frame with finely molded decoration,
