

Icon To The Virgin, The Child And The Saints



## Description

This beautiful icon of private devotion is set in a later embrace and coated with a copper oklad very thin, repoussé and silver. The latter has been disassembled for examination of the icon itself, we have reassembled it only with scotch pieces in order to let the buyer decide what he will do. Painted on a panel 27 X 38 cm, slightly convex and stiffened by an embedded crosspiece, the scene presents several registers, above the Mother of God blessing and holding a veil between David (with the harp) and Moses (holding the tables of The law), below the Christ child between Anne and Joaquim and on his left Saint Joseph accompanied by a small child (Christ again?). Originally destined to be covered with rice, the composition is placed in large strokes justly laid, only the parts intended to be discovered being

The side less Bysantinian than on the classical icons of Russia makes me think that this one comes perhaps from Ukraine.
