Lantern movement with one needle and dial in tin on a brass plate engraved with flowers and foliage, signed Le Bel in Orbec.

The lanterns and feet are brass turned.It sounds the hours and a half with two hammers on a bell. Escape to verge. She owns her weights. Signed movement of a Norman clockmaker difficult to find.

It is in good general condition, it remains to clean it to give him a second life.
