Theodore (1805 - 1875) French pastellist painter
Born in Metz in 1805. Died in Paris on April
20th, 1875 He is the father of the painter Henri
Fantin-Latour. Endowed for drawing and
painting, Theodore Fantin-Latour studies in the
workshop of the painter of History Benjamin
Rolland (1777-1855) at the Art School of
Grenoble. Under the influence of his teacher
(himself a student of Jacques-Louis David),
disciple of neoclassicism, Fantin Latour became
master of drawing and forms rendering. In 1834,
he gets married with the daughter of the countess
