A night-time clock by Eugéne FARCOT

Diameter of the dial: 12 cm

The needle is fixed, the dial turns in 24h.

Manual winding mechanism.

The ball balance is visible under the dial Behind, above the mechanism, a blown glass oil lamp (the lock washer holding the wick floats on the oil.) Illuminates from the back the dial frosted glass. Very good condition, the neck of the cariatid has been restored.
