Painter of lively compositions, scenes, portraits, landscapes, still-life, flowers She was the Niece of Berthe Morisot, of whom she was the pupil. She exhibited in Paris, at the "Salon of French Artists" starting from 1894, then at the "Salon d'automne" in 1904, and "Salon des Tuileries" in 1926. She
