Georges Jeannin, Eugene Claude, Madeleine Lamaire, Eugene Cauchois, Paul Biva and Edmond Van Coppenolle. Like his contemporaries, Coppenolle's work was greatly influenced by the Impressionists, often capturing the softness and beauty of his subject with a robust brushwork and a colorful palette.
