Czech Republic 1780-1857. Lunar river
landscape with fishermen and castle ruins. Signed
and dated Jenny Salm. 1818. Oil on canvas, 49 x
62 cm. With the inscription on the back: "Johanna
Altgräfin zu Salm-Reifferscheid geb Gräfin Pächta
Rayhofen." Only a handful of works by this
Czech artist are known, all in public collections,
three landscapes and two fixed paintings. The
current painting is his oldest known work.
