Four spoons of the same series (length: 14.2 cm) Two to the same model, a little longer (14.5 cm) Hallmark for Strasbourg 1750-1789 (13 fleur de lysé, for 13 Lot, ie ~ 812/1000 or IX deniers) Traces not deciphered goldsmith hallmarks.

Very good quality of the vermeil (worn, as often, at the point of attachment of the spoons).
