Description

Pair of cylindrical copper and polychrome cloisonné enamels on silver foil with iris decoration on a navy blue background.

This technique of enamel on silver foil is called ginbari.

Ginbari is a Japanese technique that uses silver foil in relief under the enamel. Cloisons are attached to the sheet and filled with colored enamel.

Mark stamped under the base of Hayashi Kihyoe.
