This 1928 model was the last car designed for the Mercedes-Benz brand by the engineer Ferdinand Porsche before he left the manufacturer. The car had a maximum speed of 190 km/h, making it the fastest car of its time. From 1927 until the 1930s, the racing versions of the Mercedes-Benz Type-S36/220 excelled in endurance racing and hill climbing.

In 1929, the car won the 500 Miles (800 km) of Argentina, the British Tourist Trophy and the Grand Prix of Cordoba. The year 1930 was marked by his victories at the Grand Prix of Cordoba, Ireland. In 1931, the model S32/220 was on the podium of the Grand Prix of Argentina and the Mille Miglia, this endurance race that had been taking place since 1927 (it ended in 1957) on 1618 kms of open road between Brescia and Rome.
