It was one of the first tourist sites on the Costa Brava. This landscape is painted on hardboard and signed lower left A.Munöz, dedicated "to Marguarete". It is located "Calella de Palafruguéll" on the back. Alberto Munöz Boquera is a Spanish painter, born in Barcelona in 1925 Pupil of Juan Senna he specializes in landscape and still lifes.
