



## German Hunting Saber 17th Century

### Description

Interesting typically Germanic hunting saber

BLADE: Slightly curved, a fuller on each side.

Falsecutting edge on the 16 centimeters near the point ..

Markings of stars and of a crescent moon, very similar to those encountered on sabers from

Hungary, or Austria. Blade length = 61 cm

GUARD: Protective shell in the shape of a scallop shell. Guard branch with a curved quillon, the branch arc rises near the pommel.

POMMEL: steel, chiseled in a pattern "en suite" with the GUARD shell.

GRIP : in deer antler, as it is classic to find on a hunting weapon

This type of saber is not very common, we can date it from the last quarter of the 17th century.
