WMF: Württembergische Metallwarenfabrik AG, is a German company founded in 1853 in Geislingen an der Steige by Daniel Straub and the Schweizer brothers, specializing in silverware and metallurgy. By 1900, WMF was the world's largest producer and exporter of metal products for households, mainly in Art Nouveau.
