This famous edition is illustrated with 246 color compositions by Eugène Grasset. This avant-garde book announces the art nouveau.

This is the first time that photogravure and collotype have been used, processes invented by Charles Gillot allowing the gradation of shades to be reproduced with high quality, thus marking a key date in the evolution of illustration printing techniques. . It was around 1890 that Grasset appeared as the leader of a new trend in the decorative arts, later called Art Nouveau. Rare and in exceptional condition.
