Pair of 17th century armchairs in walnut covered with a tapestry with flowers and birds Very beautiful pair in turned walnut of Périgord origin, Louis XIII period Baluster feet at the front, rear legs with 8 sides 19th tapestry made in 1/2 point for the floral motifs and 1/4 point for the birds This process makes it possible to highlight certain motifs compared to the other Seats entirely pegged Armrests turned typically Louis XIII as well as the central crosspiece below and that of the facade Good general condition Restorations of use: tips of the rear and front feet over 4 cm as well as the wooden square under the seat (restorations made in the 19th century) h: 90.7 cm depth: 47.5 cm width: 59.8 cm Seat: h: 47.5 cm depth: 37 cm width: 50.2 cm h backrest: 42.3 cm
